With this information, an AOWL psychologist will develop a plan to remediate learning challenges using proven strategies and interventions.

### **Essential Job Functions**

- Provides student clinical interviews, assessments and feedback sessions.
- Scores assessments and surveys. Synthesizes results, reviews records, and consults with other sources.
- Makes formal recommendations regarding educational accommodations.
- Serves as a consultant to parents to enhance their understanding of neurological and behavioral performance.
